The Design Department is hoping to take all Year 11 GCSE and Years 12 & 13 A Level Art and Photography students on a trip to Tate Britain and Tate Modern on Tuesday 25th February 2025. This is an excellent opportunity for students to experience some of the world's most significant contemporary Art and Photography, and help develop ideas for their final GCSE/A Level coursework piece.

All students will be visiting the public galleries in both Tate Britain and Tate Modern where a variety of classical and contemporary art will inspire and provoke their creativity. At Tate Britain we will visit "The 80's Photographing Britain" Exhibition. We will then travel from Tate Britain to Tate Modern.

The cost of the trip is £40.00 and as places are limited, they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Should there not be enough interest, the trip may not be viable - in that case all monies paid would be refunded and this decision will be taken on Friday 24th January 2025. **The trip will be closed as soon as all places have been taken so you are encouraged to secure a place via ParentPay as soon as possible to avoid disappointment for your child.**
