**Re: Y8 Performing Arts Trip – Macbeth – Aylesbury Waterside Theatre – Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025**

We have an unmissable opportunity to attend a performance of Macbeth at Aylesbury Waterside Theatre on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025.

Shakespeare's "Macbeth" performance at Aylesbury Waterside theatre is a live theatre experience that goes beyond the classroom. Watching the play unfold on stage provides a unique opportunity for your student to engage with the text in a dynamic and memorable way. The visual and emotional impact of the performance enhances comprehension and empathy, making the themes and characters more relatable. This cultural exposure not only deepens their understanding of the play but also broadens their perspective on literature and history. This experience encourages critical thinking and analysis, fostering a love for the arts and inspiring creativity. A multi-sensory journey that transcends traditional learning, your student will discover the power and beauty of Shakespeare in a live theatrical setting.

We will be leaving school at 11.30am and will travel by coach to the theatre. Students must wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch. The performance starts at 1pm and we would anticipate students being ready for collection from school by approximately 4.30pm.

**The cost of the trip is £37.75 and the trip will be closed as soon as all places have been taken or on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January so we can confirm actual ticket numbers with the venue.** Therefore, you are encouraged to secure a place via ParentPay as soon as possible to avoid disappointment for your child. We will then open up a reserve list.

Please make payment via ParentPay and complete the emergency contact and medical details sections on your ParentPay account. You are also asked if you agree to your child being photographed/recorded which may be used on social media.

**Your commitment for your child to attend is non-refundable, regardless of reason (unless covered by insurance) or unless a replacement student can be found for them which we would endeavour to do.** This is because non-refundable tickets will be purchased specifically and travel and associated trip costs will be spread across the expected cohort.
