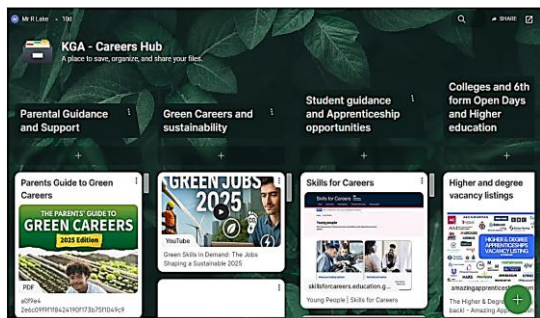
KAEP and Unifrog: Working Together to Enhance Careers Education

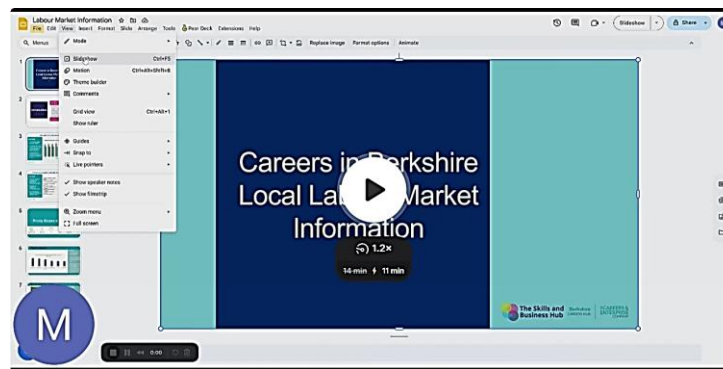
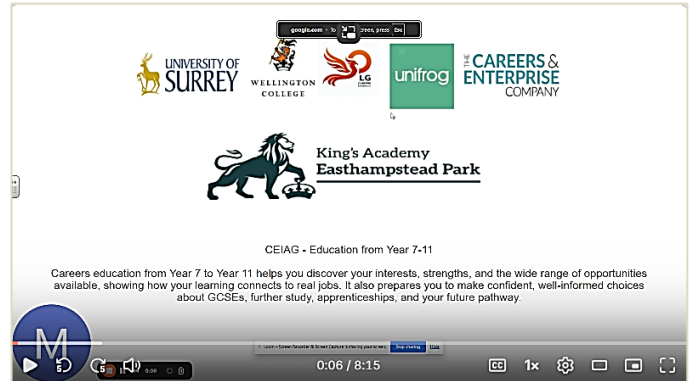
Please refer to the Parental Learning Journey document for an overview of key careers activities taking place this year.
