### KAEP and Unifrog: Working Together to Enhance Careers Education




At the start of 2025, we partnered with **Unifrog** to deliver a personalised careers programme for all students in Years 7–13. Every student has now registered with Unifrog and completed the introductory modules. Throughout their time at KAEP, students will build a personal careers portfolio and explore a wide range of opportunities, including:




